

Do you remember the verse... on obedience?

It is not always necessary to be able to quote passages word for word to know what God has said and be able to tell someone else about it. It is needful, however, to know where to find scriptures of importance on various topics and discussions in the Word of God.

Today, consider the importance of obedience. We live in a world that often believes the necessity of obedience to God only goes so far. They see it only as important or necessary to a certain point. Find and consider the following passages (and their contexts) to be reminded of the importance of obedience in our service to God.

- 1) Do you remember the verse where the prophet tells the king, "to obey is better than sacrifice"?
- 2) Do you remember the verse where the apostles told the Jewish leaders, "we ought to obey God rather than men"?
- 3) Do you remember where Jesus said, "If you love me, keep my commandments"?
- 4) Do you remember where we are told that Jesus learned obedience by the things he suffered?
- 5) Do you remember where Paul told his readers that to whom we present ourselves as servants to obey, that is who we serve?

These verses, and others like them, show just how important obedience is in our relationship with God. It's necessity and value cannot be overstated. Are we obedient?
